The Kamloops Fire Centre would like to remind everyone involved with the burning of piled debris since September 30, 2005, to ensure that any fires that were ignited are *completely out*.

The snow pack this year is quite variable, so the chance of holdover fires from over winter burning may be higher than normal.


If a fire does occur from your burning activities, you may be responsible for all fire suppression costs and damages that may occur. An administrative penalty may also be levied if you are found to be in contravention of the Wildfire Act and Regulations.
